Greetings and Happy New Year to all! 2026 promises to be a fantastic year.

Here are just a few things that may be of interest to you.

- Our programs for the Winter session will start soon. Registration for the winter session opened on December 1<sup>st</sup>. Please visit [www.nrgi.ca](http://www.nrgi.ca) to register. There are still spots available for ***Badminton, Whist & Zumba*** and there is one spot for ***Pickleball*** on Sunday. Programs that are at capacity are ***Floor Curling, Forever in Motion, Pickleball (Wednesday), & Volleyball***. As you may be aware, memberships are valid from September 1, 2025 to August 31, 2026. A community membership (from any community association) is required to register for our programs.
- Our snow angels have been busy this past month clearing snow. Although the program is now closed, we may be able to offer assistance as long as you hold a community membership for NRG. - The city of Regina completed their budget deliberations and I am happy to advise that our program funding for 2026 has been approved! Kudos to the city administration, councillors and the mayor for undertaking this difficult task.

- Did you know that the city of Regina operates 8 indoor arenas, six shinny sites and more than 50 outdoor rinks- of which 40 are now open? Take advantage of some outdoor time and strap on the blades!
- Wondering about the construction on McCarthy Blvd? This project is part of the SouthWest Sewer Upgrade Project and pipe lining will continue during the 2026 construction season. Relining cannot be completed during the winter due to cold weather.
- Size *still* matters! Did you know you could request a smaller brown cart to save you \$? Please visit [City of Regina | Cart Swap Request](#) or call 306-777-7000. The current costs will be reduced in 2026! **\$240.90**/year for a large 360 L brown cart (down from \$284.70) and **\$149.65**/year for a smaller 240 L cart (down from \$193.45).
